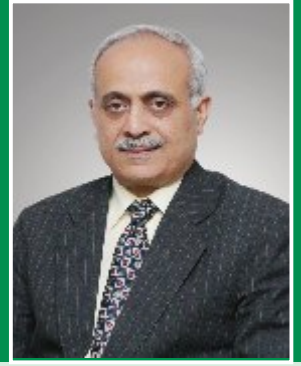

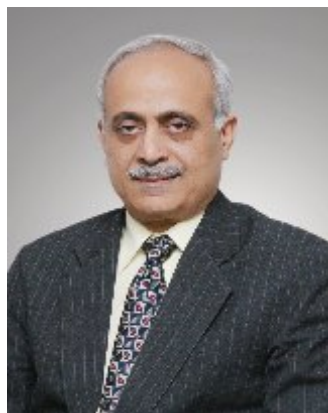

## UAF Sub-Campus Burewala Got 1st Position in Annual Flower Show 2016

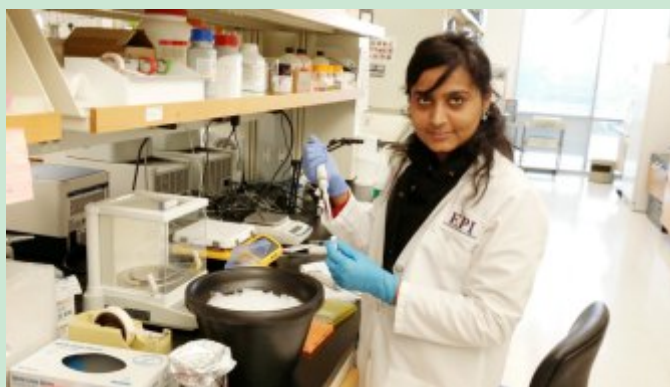
